

## P-Drive

### **What is the P: drive?**

The P drive is a network drive that allows KSU faculty to provide-class related files to their students. The drive contains folders for each academic department. The Students can access the P drive to use the files posted by their professors.

### **Do I need to request access to the P: drive?**

All KSU instructors and students should have access to the P: drive.

To Access the P drive:

1. Double Click on My Computer Icon on the desk top (Campus Computers Only)
2. Double Click on the P drive Icon
3. You will be able to view all the Dept Folders

### **What rights are available on the P: drive?**

Instructors have read, write, and delete rights to their folders.

Students only have read right to the P drive. Students do not have the ability to modify.

### **Can I access the P: drive remotely?**

No. In order to access the P: drive you must use a campus computer.
